"Even though we face the difficulties of today and tomorrow, I still have a dream.

It is a dream deeply rooted in the American dream.

I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed:

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal."

- Rev. Martin Luther King Jr.

These words written by the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. - the core of one the best known and influential speeches in American history - still resonate with us today as we celebrate what would have been his 95th birthday. On the steps of Washington D.C.'s Lincoln Memorial at the massive 1963 civil rights march, King actually went completely off script as he began powerfully sharing his vision. He said he saw black and white children holding hands, of our country turning into an oasis of freedom. Where all finally would be free at last. Free at last. Thank God Almighty, free at last.

He courageously told us his dream 61 years ago. And died for it seven months later. And where is our country today? Where are we today? Where are you today? Isn't it our time now to "tell them about the dream?"




