MUUvies for Change June viewing is "The Green Book" Director: Peter Farrelly

It is a drama set in the 1960s about a racist Italian American man (<u>Viggo Mortensen</u>) who takes a temporary job chauffeuring an acclaimed black pianist (<u>Mahershala Ali</u>) during his concert tour of the Midwest and Deep South. It explores how the two men had to abide by the titular Green Book, a "traveling while black" guide to restaurants and accommodations that showed blacks in the '60s where they could go. The film's messages about empathy and the danger of prejudice and stereotypes are important and thought-provoking. And the story is a timely reminder of how, just a few decades ago, there were whole parts of the country where segregation kept African Americans from fully participating in civic life.
