During this time of harvesting and feasting, we find ourselves reflecting on what we are grateful for. For some of us, gratitude is a daily practice. We've known for a long time that cultivating a spirit of gratitude helps decrease anxiety and depression and may even prevent illness. And we now know that the more we express our gratitude, the more generous we become. It's not just good for us, it's good for others. Christina Karns, Ph.D., a researcher at the University of Oregon, has mapped the relationship between gratitude and altruism in the brain and discovered the neural connection between the two is very deep, and that cultivating gratitude may encourage us to feel more generous. So, join us on Sunday, as we share our gratitude and cultivate a spirit of generosity.
