From our congregation policy: A Friend of the Congregation is a person who is involved in the congregation but might not prefer to join. This includes:

- non-members who financially contribute
 - parents of children enrolled in religious education
 - former members who have moved away, but still retain a connection such as continuing to receive our weekly newsletter
 - participants in outreach programs such as college campus group or military ministry group that the congregation sponsors.
1. Friends will be identified as such in the Congregational administrative database by the Office Administrator.
 2. Friends will be solicited for financial pledging as part of the Annual Budget Drive.
 3. Friends may be listed in an area of the Member Directory (but will have the same ability as members to opt out of being listed).
 4. Friends will have access to the Member section of the website, but access to the Membership Directory information is limited to only the names, phone numbers, and email addresses of adult members and friends.
